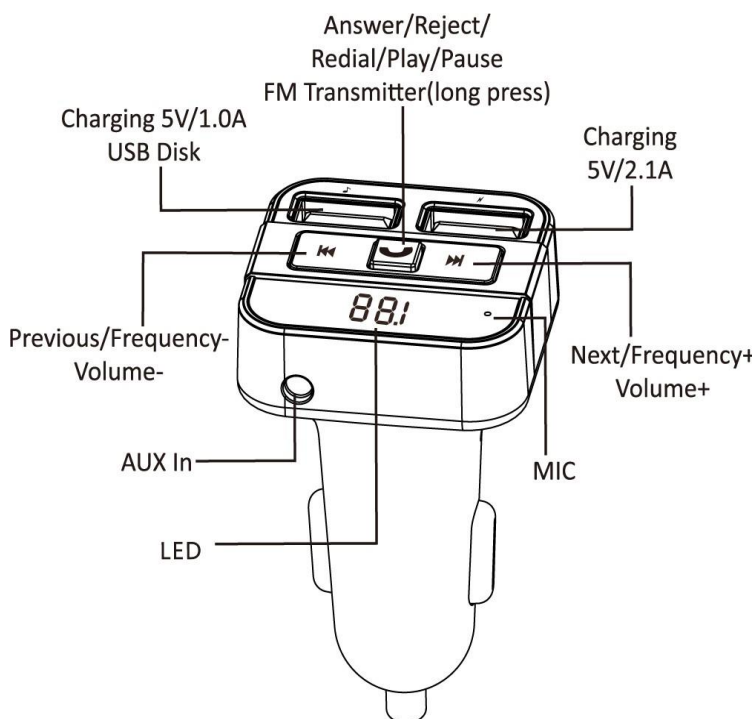
A compact, hands-free car kit to wirelessly transmit phone calls and music from your Bluetooth device to your vehicle's FM radio. Features include a clear LED display, inbuilt media player and twin USB ports to ensure you're fully charged on the go.



### Operation guide





#### Pairing with your vehicle's FM radio:

Plug the transmitter into your vehicle's cigarette lighter socket and it will automatically power on. Turn on the stereo system and switch to FM radio mode. Manually scan through the frequency to find an available channel, trying to make it as far away from existing channels as possible to avoid interference. Next, long press the call answer button  to make the channel frequency on the LED display flash, then navigate to the same frequency as your car stereo using the frequency up and down buttons  &  on the unit.

#### Connecting to your smartphone using Bluetooth:

Enter your smartphone's Bluetooth device list and search for the pairing name **"AV:Link-BTHF1"** and select to pair, if asked for a pairing code enter **"0000"**. Once paired you will hear a confirmation tone and you are now able to make and receive hands-free telephone calls using the microphone in the transmitter and your car speakers for the incoming audio. To answer a phone call, press the call answer button  in the centre of the unit once, to reject the call press it twice. To redial the last number in your phone's memory, press the call answer button twice in no call status mode. You can also listen to audio content on your smartphone using the inbuilt MP3 player. Use the track control buttons on top of the unit   to play/pause, move up and down the tracks or control the master volume by long pressing accordingly.



#### Listening to music through the USB port:

The transmitter also has an inbuilt media player capable of playing MP3/WMA files from a USB drive inserted into the USB disk port. Ensure the inserted media is no larger than 64GB in size and is formatted in FAT32 status, then use the track control buttons on the top of the unit   to play/pause, move up and down the tracks or control the master volume by long pressing accordingly.













### Using the AUX in (3.5mm) port:

Insert a 3.5mm audio cable into the port on the unit and connect to any device that transmits audio. You can now listen to the audio content through your car stereo providing the volume on the connected device is increased to an audible level. **Note:** The track control buttons on the transmitter won't work using the AUX mode.

### Using the charging ports:

The transmitter is fitted with 2 USB charging ports which can both be used to charge devices at the same time. Port 1  1A is multi-purpose and is for USB Disk function or charging devices max. 5V 1.0A. Port 2  2.1A is purely for charging and has a max. output of 5V 2.1A.

### Quick Guide:

Operation	On Bluetooth Car Kit
1.Power on/off	Plug the product into the car cigarette socket, it will power on
2.Play/Pause	Click  button once
3.Answer/Hang off Reject/ Redial	Click  button once to answer the incoming call Click  again to hang off the phone call Double click  button to reject the incoming call Under no call status, double click  to redial the last phone call
4.Volume adjustment	Long press  &  button to adjust volume
5.Change songs	Short press  &  button to adjust the songs
6.FM Frequency adjustment	Long press  button to enter the FM mode, Short press  &  button to adjust frequency

### FAQ

**Q)** Why won't my Bluetooth device pair with the transmitter. **A)** Check that your device is in Bluetooth mode and set to discoverable. If after a few minutes you are still unsuccessful, turn off both devices and try again.

**Q)** Why is the FM reception poor quality or has interference? **A)** Try moving to a different frequency and ensure there are no stations in the near vicinity.

**Q)** Why won't the content on my USB drive play? **A)** Ensure the drive is no larger than 64GB, formatted in FAT32 status and the music files are MP3 or WMA format.
